Impact of covid 19 in Education across UAE...

 On March 3, UAE's Ministry of Education announced that schools and universities across the country will close for a month starting Sunday, March 8, as part of efforts to contain the spread of coronavirus.

Until Further Notice

- On 30 March, UAE announced that the 2-week online "distance learning" for schools and universities would continue until the end of the academic year in June.
- On 23 June 2020, Ministry of Education, announced the possibility of re-opening educational institutions across the UAE as per a well-studied plan and within the precautionary measures taken by the UAE to contain the novel coronavirus. As per the ministry, the possibility of re-opening public and private universities and schools in September 2020 will depend on an assessment of the evolving situation related to COVID-19 and subject to specific health and safety procedures.

# Proposals for reopening of schools...


- Continuing with the distance learning system if the virus continues to exist until the date of the schools' re-opening in the beginning of September 2020
- Hybrid learning: Combining both, distance education and the traditional face-to-face education, during which 50 per cent of the schools' workforce will resume work in schools' campuses while adhering to all preventive and precautionary measures
- Full return to schools while implementing safety controls and procedures against COVID-19.
